



A is where the big air raid shelter had been - and the point where we gathered for the Victory Tea Party. (Now the Village Green)

B is where the party took place in front of the Mission Hall –which appears to have been replaced by two other buildings. (In actual fact this is 1 building, St Lukes Church)

C is where there was a brick air-raid shelter and the space behind that up to the white bar that I have drawn was an open 'field'. (I remember that my friends and I set it alight once - it was the easiest way to clear the grass!)

At D, opposite, those two houses were not there. That is where we had the bonfire. I remember that there was a big house to the north side, as in the photo. Everything to the right of the line I have drawn was fields.

I remember the passage way into the fields just under the name and at the side of the shops.
