One way restriction on B5130 Sandy Lane/Dee Banks/Chester Road.  
Traffic will only be permitted to travel in a north to south direction.

The MBNA Chester Marathon is the only marathon in Cheshire. This race will be a major showcase event for the area providing a significant boost to the local economy, while also raising an estimated half a million pounds for local and national charities.

Our course incorporates iconic local landmarks along the route, as it passes through both England and Wales, returning via the banks of the River Dee for a spectacular finish at The Racecourse. The route has been planned to minimise the impact on host communities, while showcasing the best that our region has to offer.

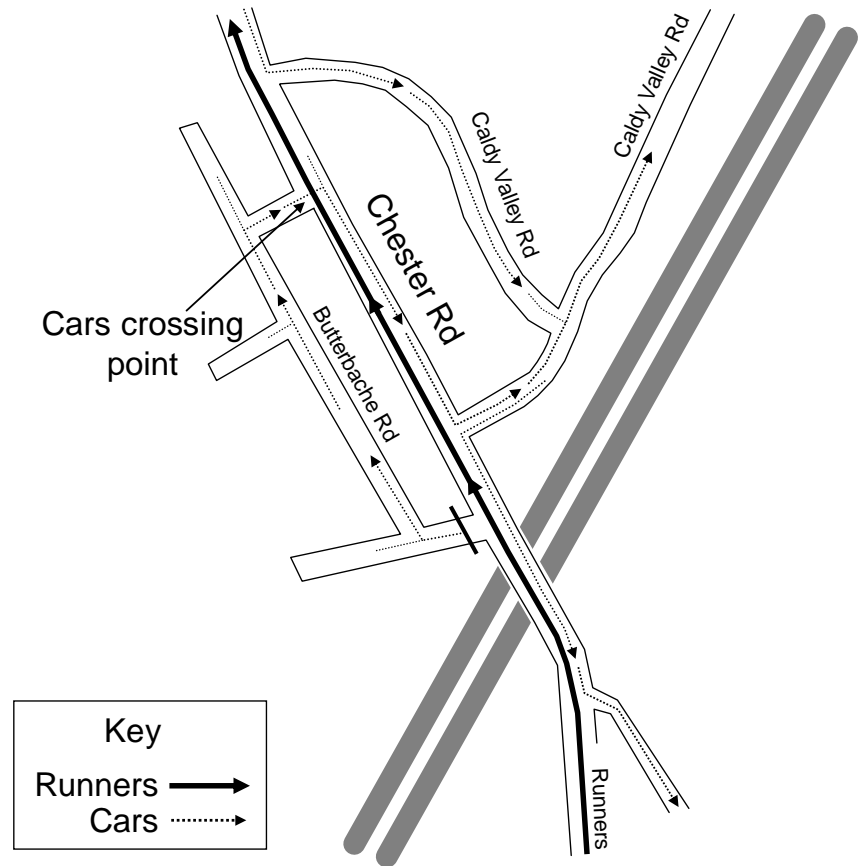
The route has been agreed with the Highways Authorities and Police and, to ensure the safety of runners, spectators and members of the public, the race will take place on closed roads and no vehicles will be allowed on the route apart from emergency services.

For residents on Butterbache Rd, Meadow Lane, Riversmead, Bachefield Ave and Woodlands Rd who want to leave during the race, there will be marshals to help you to exit safely. You will be diverted out of Woodlands Road to the south via Chester Rd. You won't be able to re-enter while the race is on. During the road closures, diversions will be in place. Roads will only be closed for the minimum period necessary to ensure safety.

Runners are near the end of their race as they run through Huntington, and they will appreciate some encouragement – so why not go outside and cheer. Keep your eyes open for the Huntington residents taking part in this international field.
