It was agreed that Mark Williams would chair the meeting.

To agree role of working Group including which parts of the field the group will consider.

The group agreed it will consider all areas of the field including the play area. It was noted that the group's considerations will have to take into account the consultation under way on how the open space/106 money will be spent as this is likely to have some impact on the Jubilee Field.

To consider/identify maintenance requirements of the field.

The grass in both the goal areas and the centre has been worn away and was prone to becoming muddy. It was agreed that sand could be used in the worst areas to aid drainage; this could be raked and levelled.

It was agreed that the group would ask the Parish Council for a maximum of £200 to purchase 1 tonne of sand and a small amount of top soil and grass seeds to carry out some remedial work in the worst effected areas.

It was agreed that a 5-a-side pitch would also be marked out by the Hoole Hornets which it was hoped would allow the main pitch to be used less.

Other Matters

It was noted that the football season runs September to May during which time the pitch is used for training on a Saturday morning and matches on a Sunday. Out of season the team trains on a Thursday evening and Saturday morning.

It was also agreed that the group would seek permission from Huntington Parish Council for the Hoole Hornets to hold a junior 6-a-side tournament during June or July, the Huntington Parish Cup.
