1. The Minutes of the meeting held on Monday 18th April 2006 were agreed and signed
2. **St. Luke's Church Report**

Rev Ian Hutchings presented the parish report of St. Luke's Church (notes attached).

Cllr. John Creswick suggested both the Church and Parish Council co-operate in trying to raise community awareness in, for example, encouraging people to vote at local elections which Rev. Hutchings welcomed.

3. **Chairman's Report**

The Chairman read out her report for the year (attached) and highlighted the following:

A Toucan Crossing had now been installed on Chester Road. She also thanked Mr Partington and Diana Gaulton for the new planting on the village green. There are still problems with dog fouling on the Jubilee Field and residents need to be vigilant over the Saughton Camp developments. She also thanked the Parish Clerk for her work and , as it would be the Chairman's last meeting, the Councillors for their hard work throughout the year.

Cllr. John Creswick proposed a vote of thanks to the Chairman which was seconded by Cllr. John Moore and said he was sorry she was not continuing as a Parish Councillor.

Cllr. Treloar has asked ChALC to keep in touch with the clerk on the matter of the road noise from the A55 and also with the Chair of Eccleston Parish Council as they also receive a lot of complaints about the road noise.

4. Friends of Caldby Nature Park

A report was received from Friends of Caldby Nature Park which was read out by the Chairman (attached).

As a result of the report, the Clerk was asked to contact Val Hornby, Secretary of the Friends of Caldby Nature Park, to pass on thanks to Ken Hill, their Press Officer who wrote the report and also to pass on concerns of the Parish Council at the number of trees which had recently been cut down and to ask if they could be removed as many people thought it encouraged vandalism and gave the impression that residents bordering the nature park could also cut down trees within it.

A report was received from the Secretary of Huntington WI (attached) and read out to the meeting by the Chairman.
