## CHESTER ROAD PARKING & MAINTENANCE

**CHESTER ROAD VERGES** - The disruption caused by the gas line replacement in and around Huntington is now almost complete.

Unfortunately, the works has caused a lot of damage to the verges, particularly on Chester Road - this coupled with the heavy frosts and snow has made it difficult to fully reinstate the verges quickly. In order to prevent further deterioration, and to allow the verges to start growing again naturally - we ask that residents **do not drive, park or walk on the soft soil.**

This will prevent expensive remedial work being required at a later date. The Parish Council is continuing to work with the contractors and the Council to ensure the verges are fully reinstated when the weather allows.



## PARISH ASSEMBLY – *Something completely different!*

This year's **Parish Assembly will be something different** – we have invited organisations from the Huntington Community to create a small display about what they do locally.

Residents will be able to learn about these groups and what happens in your village in a friendly and open atmosphere. Some of these organisations include: Friends of Caldy Valley Nature Park, Hoole Hornets Football Club, St. Luke's Church, CW&C Community Safety Wardens, Huntington Under 5's, Huntington Seniors, the Village Hall Committee plus many more. There will be several presentations - which will be of interest to the majority of residents in Huntington - including new parking restrictions and proposed speed restrictions on Chester Road and the launch of Huntington Parish Council 'Open Spaces' consultation.
