Employment

No Council employee or job applicant will receive less favourable treatment on the grounds of race, colour, nationality, ethnic or national origin, gender, gender reassignment, marital status, sexual orientation, disability, trade union activity, age, religion or belief, social or economic status, political beliefs, or will be disadvantaged by conditions or requirements which cannot be justified.

Service Delivery

The Council, recognising its responsibilities as a provider of services within the community, will ensure that its services, including the ones carried out in partnership with or on behalf of the Council, are available equally to all, regardless of race, colour, nationality, ethnic origins, gender, gender reassignment, marital status, sexual orientation, disability, age, religion or belief, social or economic status or political beliefs, making sure that no one is disadvantaged by conditions or requirements which cannot be justified.
