Proposal 1

I have spoken to Rev Chris and he is happy with the idea of the following (the timings are what he has proposed):

10am – PROMPT start of the Service at St Lukes' Church

10:30am – Service finishes and parade forms in the Car Park

10:35am – 10:50am – Parade down Chester Road

10:50am – Memorial service at Saighton Camp Memorial including readings and Act Of Remembrance at 11am

11:15am – Dedication of any sculpture that the Parish Council may/may not decide upon

Proposal 2: To place a commemorative bench at the Saighton Camp memorial



Price for our WW1 bench seat is £647 +VAT +Delivery.

A stainless steel memorial/dedication plaque can also be supplied attached to the bench if required and the additional cost for a 120x80mm size complete with engraving of up to 45 words is £49 +VAT.
